General Cleaning Recommendation:

- Clean only with water based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Cleaning by a professional service is recommended.

Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain. For best results follow cleaning steps in order:

Regular Cleaning and Maintenance

(Dirt, Dust, Grime)

Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

Food Stains / Oils

(Ketchup, Chocolate, Coffee, Tea, Juice)

Wipe affected area with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush using a non-abrasive cleaner, for example Formula 409® or Fantastik®. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

Healthcare Stains

(Blood, Urine, Betadine, Disinfectant)

Clean the soiled area with a 10% solution of Household Bleach and water. Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the bleach solution and wipe dry.

Difficult Stains

(Eye Shadow/Mascara, Lipstick, Crayon, Grease, Mustard)

Clean the soiled area with 50% solution of Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol) and water. Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the alcohol solution (bleach solution).

Ink Stains

(Ballpoint Pen, Permanent Marker, Paint)

Rub the marked area with Undiluted Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol). Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water promptly after applying the alcohol.

Note: It is not guaranteed that ink stains can be removed. To achieve the best results, it is recommended to clean the stain immediately.

Bleach Cleaning

1. Before bleach-cleaning, make sure fabric is dry and has been vacuumed, and that the space is ventilated.
2. Prepare a 10% bleach solution in water.
3. Test the solution in an inconspicuous location first before applying over the rest of the fabric.
4. Apply the cleaning solution using a misting spray bottle.
5. Work the solution into the affected area by lightly scrubbing the area with a sponge or soft bristle brush.
Make sure to work from the outside of the stain inward so as not to spread the stain and rinse your sponge or brush frequently.
6. Allow cleaning solution to linger for the time specified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
7. Rinse thoroughly to remove all bleach residues from the fabric.
8. Allow fabric to air dry.

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Cleaners only recommended if diluted per manufacturer's instructions. Topical cleaners must be wiped off with clean water and dried with a clean cloth following application. For any cleaner not listed, please inquire at 800.223.5466 x4882.
