

Cleaning Guide



Pattern:	Threads
AC#:	65140 - 65148
Content:	100 Vinyl Face, 100% Polyester Back
Bleach Cleanable:	May be cleaned with bleach following the proper ratio of 90% water : 10% bleach.
Finish:	Ink Resistant
Cleaning Code:	WS



General Cleaning Recommendation:

Use a clean cloth with mild soap and water first, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

If water or mild detergent does not clean soiled area, apply a non-abrasive cleaner, for example **Formula 409®** or **Fantastik®** using a soft cloth or soft brush. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

It is acceptable to clean and disinfect with a 10% solution of bleach and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the bleach solution because of the drying properties of bleach.

For stubborn marks, clean the soiled area with 50% solution of Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol) and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the alcohol solution.

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
